#### PREFACE

The following information is the outline vision for the National Evangelism & Missions Department. The vision is a work in progress and will continue to develop as the department grows into what God desires it to become.

The reason for our mission statement is to provide an insight into our mandate 21<sup>st</sup> Century era and as the new National Evangelism & Missions Department.

Together we will seek the Lords guidance through persistent prayer and fasting, so that above all we aim to achieve within the department, our desires will be to fulfil the Will of the Lord even more!

The National Evangelism and Missions Department consist of the Director Rev Dave Brown and eight regional directors covering eight regions. The names of the appointed Regional Directors and the regions they are responsible for are summarized as follows: (See Appendix 2 for more details)

- Put on /support Evangelism and outreach/mission events within their region (Towns and Cities)

## INTRODUCTION

The vision of the National Evangelism and Missions Department is to carry out the mandate given to us by the New Testament Church of God Administrative Bishop and the National Executive Council for England and Wales. This is pertaining to the vision of the National Church for England and Wales, particularly Evangelism and Church Planting. We aim to make Evangelism, Missions and Church planting a priority in the hearts and minds of all those affiliated with the New Testament Church of God England and Wales.

Winning souls for the Kingdom of God and making disciples of them is our chief motive, so they in turn will be empowered to go out and do likewise!

Within the following vision outline, there are three additional areas of evangelism and missions that are included: Private Christian Schools, Health and Well-being and Horticulture. These are specifically included in order to target the areas of the mind, body and soul of our people. Enabling our children to be taught Godly principles from an early age, not just in Sunday school but throughout the week. Helping our people to be responsible for their bodies and to take care of it as God intended for them to do and finally for everyone to engage in healthy eating habits, by being part of the organic food growing process and partaking of the produce that they would have helped to grow.

Ultimately, a healthy mind-set will help maintain a healthy body and a healthy body and lifestyle will help maintain a healthy mind-set.

The document is set out in three particular sections to identify the National Evangelism and Missions Department goals: short term goals (1-2 yrs), medium term goals (3-5yrs) and long-term goals (5+yrs)

## **SHORT TERM GOALS**

Our short term goals are set out under the headings of the following section:

### **EVANGELISM AND CHURCH PLANTING**

#### **Church Planting Information Pack**

The National Evangelism and Missions Department will produce a Church planting information pack for those who feel the call for Church Planting. This will be a useful resource to help them get started. The pack will provide a guideline and a set of basic processes for planting and maintaining a new Church. The Church planting information pack will help to give confidence and a sense of direction to the called Church Planter.

As part of our short-term goal we are aiming to plant at least two churches one of which has already been planted by our SOUTH WEST ENGLAND REGIONAL Director in Swindon, 'NTCG Praise Engine' located in Eldene Community Centre, Eldene, Swindon, SN3 3RZ.

#### **Training and Equipping**

The National Evangelism and Missions Department will aim to organize training and equipping events to train and equip our Churches in Evangelism, Missions and Church Planting, from a local, district and regional level. This will be ongoing as an integral part of our medium and long term goals.

#### **Fund Raising Strategy and Committees**

Appended to this vision document is an example of a funding strategy that we have put in place to secure funds for the National Evangelism and Missions department, which will aid the work we plan to do. The strategy will be issued to all our NTCG churches within England and Wales for their participation in the strategy. (See Appendix 1)

Working alongside the funding strategy, each district will be asked to create an Evangelism & Missions Fund Raising Committee, to spear head the accessing of funding streams that will also assist in financing their local activities. Also, to support the National Evangelism & Missions Department and the Life Changing activities/projects that we embark on, these funding streams can be via regular donations or via official funding bodies.

The National Evangelism & Missions Department will aim to set up training and equipping sessions around the country, to explain the National funding strategy in detail and to facilitate the committees with relevant knowledge and information during the process.

## **PROJECT FOCUS**

### **Health and Well-being**

The National Evangelism & Missions Department will aim to pioneer at least one NTCG Health and Well-being Center within each region. The aim is to provide health and well-being services for their respective Churches and communities.

We will aim to establish a Well-being Committee within each district if possible to spearhead the charge in establishing a Health and Well-being Centre within each district.

The National Evangelism & Missions Department will provide support where possible and aim to set up training and equipping sessions around the country, to facilitate the committees with relevant knowledge and information during the process.

Currently we are working with CAHNs Health and Wellbeing, which aims, to provide an early intervention and prevention services for improved health and wellbeing within the community settings.

Its objectives are:

- To develop health, wellbeing, and advisory services within a framework of good governance
- To provide dedicated and equipped teams of experienced community health liaison ambassadors across CAHN hubs
- To provide health liaison ambassadors with the tools to effectively cascade learning to community citizens to enable sustainability
- To educate, empower and promote tailored and bespoke health and wellbeing behaviours amongst citizens and other stakeholders
- To partner and collaborate with other agencies from across sectors to offer complementary services
- To consult, assess, review and evaluate services
- To impact policy and practice decisions about the health and wellbeing needs of the community

## **MEDIUM TERM GOALS**

Our medium-term goals are set out under the headings of the following section:

### **Church Planting**

As part of our medium-term planting strategy we aim to plant churches in the Worcester and Cradley Heath areas, which fall within the West Midlands 2 Region.

### **National 360° Month**

The National Evangelism and Missions department would also like to establish a 'National 360° Month' as part of our medium-term vision. The principle is basically to encourage every member within our churches to actively engage in evangelism and missions for a whole month, where each one aims to win one. These will be broken down in the following four stages:

- Each One invites one (outreach)
- Each One feeds one (fellowship/attending to needs)
- Each One teach one (sharing knowledge and experience)
- Each One visit one (follow up/fellowship/outreach)

The exact format should be tailored to suit each individual church and community

### **Sunday school**

The National Evangelism & Missions department will be setting up a committee to evaluate the current level of operation of the NTCG Sunday School Departments within the local Churches across the country. The purpose of the evaluation is to gain some insight into the Sunday Schools, which are currently in operation. Please note that Sunday Schools, outside of NTCG will also be looked into, if we are permitted to do so. The evaluation will include but not limited to:

- How many Sunday Schools are in operation
- How are they operating (structure, frequency, when and where)
- The attendance levels and whom actually attends
- Financial structures (management, accounting, funding arrangements)
- Travel arrangements to and from the Sunday Schools
- Resources that are currently being used and what is available to them.
- The volunteers working within the Sunday schools

Once all the information has been collated, we will work/liaise with the National Director of Youth and Discipleship to establish and extract best practices from each of the Sunday Schools evaluated. The intention is to establish a 21<sup>st</sup> Century Sunday School Department model/format that will be current, relevant, impacting and can be rolled out nationally.



## **National Evangelism & Missions – Life Changing Event (JITA)**

We intend to hold Regional Evangelism & Missions events each year, with a strong emphasis on winning souls for the Kingdom of God. This will allow each region to come together on a yearly basis and develop a combined focus and Evangelism/Missions drive. The power of God should be evident at these regional events, with the demonstration of the gift of healing and other anointed gifts.

We will aim to hold a National Evangelism & Missions Event each year bringing all the churches together, so we can share what each region have been doing for the past year and what their future plans are. This event will be free to attendees where as we seek to encourage unsaved people to attend. Costs incurred to deliver the event will be offset by free will offerings taken up or given and funds already secured via the National Funding strategy we have put in place, (see appendix 1). The hope is that the planned funding system will bring in enough funds to allow us to stage the event. Again, the power of God should be evident at these National events, with the demonstration of the gift of healing and other anointed gifts.

Our prayer focus will be for this to be an Evangelistic and Missions drive for the unsaved and needy, allowing them to attend and experience the dynamic events that we will be having and by hearing the word of God in different forms, convicting them to surrender their hearts to the Lord.

## **LONG TERM GOALS**

Our long-term goals are set out under the headings of the following section:

### **Church Planting**

As part of our long-term planting strategy we will continue with our church planting strategy and plant a church in the Blackheath areas, which again falls within the West Midlands 2 Region.

### **PROJECT FOCUS**

#### **Horticulture**

The National Evangelism & Missions Department will aim to pioneer at least one NTCG Horticulture Center within each district. The purpose of these centers is to provide organically grown food to be purchased by their respective Churches and communities. This process could include the cultivation of medicinal plants, fruits, vegetables, nuts, seeds, herbs, sprouts, mushrooms, algae, flowers, seaweed and non-food crops such as grass and ornamental trees and plants.

This would be a gateway for the community at large to become involved with and work abreast the churches thus providing opportunities for evangelism and a mission source in that food will be provided for the community.

We will aim to establish a Horticulture committee within each district where possible to spearhead the charge in establishing a Horticulture Centre within their district. The National Evangelism & Missions Department will provide support where possible and aim to assist in identifying individuals who are skilled in this field and to set up training and equipping sessions around the country, to facilitate the committees with relevant knowledge and information during the process.

#### **Private Christian Schools**

The National Evangelism & Missions Department, will aim to pioneer at least one NTCG Private Christian School within each region, ensuring that Godly principles are integral to the students daily learning process. Eventually it is our aim that a Committee will be set up at district level to encourage the establishment of private Christian Schools in each district where feasible.

The National Evangelism & Missions Department will provide support where possible and aim to set up training and equipping sessions around the country, to facilitate the committees with relevant knowledge and information, during the process.

## **CONCLUDING POINTS**

### **Prayer**

It really should go without saying, that undergirding all that the National Evangelism & Missions Department plans to do and indeed even just to function, will be prayer. We will be requesting regular prayer support from our local and district churches, to bear us up and pray God's blessing and guidance upon all our plans.

As we continue to pray together seeking God's continued guidance and direction as a department, we desire to open our hearts and our minds, so that the Spirit of the Lord will permeate and fill us with His wisdom, knowledge and understanding. We will pray that by His Power and Spiritual Anointing, selfish desires and praise seeking will be eradicated from our lives and that our sole purpose and drive will be, 'Not my will, but Thy will be done'. We will be seeking only to lift up the name of Jesus, through every programme, activity and project, to the Glory of God the Father and honour of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

## APPENDIX 1

### NTCG EVANGELISM & MISSIONS FUNDING STRATEGY

This funding strategy that we have put in place is to help secure funds to support the work of the National Evangelism & Missions Department and where possible the regional events. The figures used are indicative and for guidance only, to demonstrate the principle of how the strategy will work.

For example if we were to assume that we have a total membership of 10,000 people within the NTCG throughout England and Wales and my tenure will be for a maximum of 8No years.

My proposal is to divide the 10,000 membership evenly over the 8 years that I will be in office, which gives access to 1,250 members per year for each year for 8No years.

Therefore, we propose to ask 1,250 members from across the NTCG churches in England and Wales, to each pledge £5 - £10 per month for 12 months only into the National Evangelism & Mission pledging fund. This would bring in approximately £6,250 - £12,500 each month totaling to £75,000 - £150,000 per year.

The key point to note here is that the 1,250 members will only be asked to contribute to the pledging fund for 12 months only and then a new set of 1,250 members would be approached for the next 12 months and so on, until the end of the 8<sup>th</sup> year.

By the end of the 8th year tenure we could potentially bring in £600,000 - £1,200,000 into the National Evangelism & Missions Department Pledging Fund.

The process of dividing up the membership across the eight years can be facilitated within each local church, and the split should be relative to the membership of each local church. For example, if a church only have a membership of 50, then the 50 membership will be divided by 8, which will allocate approximately 6 members per year who will each contribute to the pledging fund for 12 months only. So 6 members in year 1 will contribute and then another 6 members in years 2 and so on, up to the end of the 8<sup>th</sup> year. Similarly, if the membership is 100, then it will be approximately 12 members per month per year from the local church contributing to the pledging fund.

It must be stressed that each member from each local church will only be asked to contribute to the National Evangelism & Missions Department Pledging Fund, for one 12-month period only during my 8 year tenure. The logistics of how the members are divided in terms of who will participate in year 1, year 2 etc. will be left to the local churches to organize.

If any member wishes to pay their pledging fund in total at the start of their 12 months period, rather than spread it over 12 months, they will be allowed to do so.

If any member wishes to participate in more than one 12-month period, they will be allowed to do so for as long as they desire, up to the end of the 8<sup>th</sup> year.

Also, if any member wishes to contribute more or less than the agreed monthly pledging figure, they will be allowed to do so.
